



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHO CAN JOIN THE BOYS & GIRLS CLUB?

Any child between the ages of 5-17 (18 if still in High School). Any adult interested in physical activity. Stop in to pick up a membership application. Youth memberships cost \$15 per year. Six-month and full-year memberships are available for adults. See adult schedule for rates.

WHEN IS THE CLUB OPEN?

The Club is open after school, evenings and Saturdays 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM during the school year. The Club is open most days 12-5 (Monday through Friday) during school holidays, school conference days and vacation periods. Adult hours are mornings and early afternoon before school dismissal. Call ahead to confirm.

ARE THERE LEAGUE ACTIVITIES?

The club offers flag football, indoor soccer, basketball, floor hockey and girls softball. Swim lessons are also available after school and on Saturday morning.

WHAT OTHER TYPES OF PROGRAMS ARE OFFERED?

The Boys & Girls Club of Jamestown is an affiliate of the national Boys & Girls Clubs of America organization which provides us with programs in the areas of character/leadership; health and life skills; the arts; and technology. Refer to the BGCA.org website for more information. Our Club has a computer lab, game rooms, an arts & crafts room, a gymnasium and a swimming pool. Stop in for a tour.

HOW ARE YOUTH MEMBERS SUPERVISED?

Our Club operates a registered after school and summer day camp program licensed by the state. Staff members are trained in youth development, conflict resolution and discipline techniques in addition to their area of expertise. All of our aquatic staff has lifesaving, CPR and first aid. There is adult supervision in all program areas. The Club does have an open door policy during open recreation hours which makes it possible for youth members to leave the facility. During the after school program and summer day camp a parent is required to sign children out.

CAN PARENTS VOLUNTEER AT THE CLUB?
